Dear Father,

I am writing on behalf of the Franciscan Custody of the Holy Land, which, as you know, cares for the Christian peoples and the Church in various regions of the Middle East.

Over the years, our Church has given very generously to the Good Friday Pontifical Collection. But, for the past two years, the Covid pandemic has upset the usual Good Friday collection. This year, dioceses could choose either to promote the Pontifical Collection on Good Friday or, as recommended by the CCCB, to take it up in September.

I know that some parishioners, parishes, and dioceses have already sent money directly to the Commissariat. But unfortunately, it is difficult to know with any certainty all the dioceses that took up the collection or whether the parishioners were able to be present and able to contribute.

Fathers, if your diocese and parish took up the Good Friday collection, I would be grateful if you thanked all parishioners on the Commissariat's behalf. At the same time, I would discretely like to remind the faithful, who were not able to participate in that collection, of the continuing needs of the people and the Church in the Holy Land.

If your diocese and parish will be taking up the Holy Land Collection on Sunday September 12, I would appreciate your thanking those parishioners who have already donated by envelopes; and, at the same time, I ask your support in promoting the Holy Land collection.

In this package, there are suggested inserts that could be used for announcements or in parish bulletins and/or websites to thank parishioners, and to announce the Holy Land collection in those parishes taking it up in September.

Additionally, you will find a poster that resounds of the readings for the Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary time, and which simply says, "The Lord God has opened my ear;" and, without giving any date, it adds "Please remember the 2021 Holy Land Collection." My hope is that this poster could be hung in every parish simply as a visual reminder, even if a collection was taken on Good Friday.

I thank you for your concern for the people and Church of the Holy Land, and for your generous support.
