Dear Father:

This year the Pontifical Collection for the Holy Land is taken up on Good Friday, April 10, 2020. We have chosen as a theme: "Creation Waits in Hope". It speaks to several issues in the Holy Land and our own world, uniting us by the hope Christ places in our hearts.

We know that the people and the Church in the Holy Land and throughout the Middle East have been contending with conflict for years. All the while that they have been in turmoil, they continue to care for the displaced and to hope for an end to the abuse and destruction of the lives and land that God has lovingly created and given to them. They are "waiting with eager longing to obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God" (Rm 8:19-21).

This theme of waiting in hope, of course, extends beyond the Holy Land to all peoples and to creation itself. Pope Francis, in his September 2019 Letter for the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, reminded us that "Now is the time to rediscover our vocation as children of God, brothers and sisters, and stewards of creation. Now is the time to repent, to be converted and to return to our roots. We are beloved creatures of God, who in his goodness calls us to love life and live it in communion with the rest of creation."

During our Good Friday and Easter celebrations, we recall that, thanks to the new life Jesus Christ has given us, we have become children of God called to show forth and to restore God's glory. On this Good Friday, by our support of the church in the Holy Land, we recognize their needs and our common vocation to live so that all people and all God's creation "will obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God".

To announce the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, please find enclosed:

- Two posters announcing the Collection, which should be displayed as of Palm Sunday.
- A notice to be published in the parish leaflet for Palm Sunday, i.e. on April 5, 2020.
- An announcement to be read during the Good Friday service, at collection time.

We thank you for sending this Pontifical Collection to your bishop who, in turn, will pass on the total offering of your diocese to us. These offerings are then forwarded in their entirety to the Holy Land.
